MINUTES OF THE EUDORA CITY COUNCIL  
SPECIAL CALL MEETING  
JANUARY 23, 2014

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mayor Stanton. Mayor Stanton brought before the council a bill from Hensley Dozer & Backhoe Inc. in the amount of \$1,800.00 to pay for 3 loads of Rotomilled asphalt.

The 2014 Eudora Proposed Budget was presented for adoption.

Chief Smith asked the council to purchase a 2012 Tahoe fully equipped from the \$35,000.00 grant money from the Bob White Foundation. Alderman Turner made the motion to look for a new vehicle and for the city attorney to check on what's the procedure for taking bids.


