**MINUTES OF THE EUDORA CITY COUNCIL
SPECIAL CALL MEETING
OCTOBER 22, 2013**

Six aldermen were present at roll call. Alderman Turner and Serio arrived shortly after.

Mrs. Bettye B. Clark and Mrs. Mary Turner were honored with a Citizenship Award.

The purpose of the meeting is (1) Extension of Term of Lease Agreement with Superior Uniform Group. The mayor's recommendation to the council is to renew the contract with Superior Uniform Group. The original contract dates back to 1967. There will be expansions made to the warehouse which will create more jobs and they will also update equipment. The factory has an annual budget of five million dollars.

Alderman Farris made the motion to renew the contract with Superior Uniform Group for 200 years. Alderman Butler seconded the motion. Alderman Serio voted no. Mrs. Serio had questions.


Mrs. Lois Ashley spoke to the council and citizens and informed them that currently employ 204 people. Their annual salary is \$4,705,000.00. 126 employees live in Eudora. 148 employees live in Chicot County and 176 in Arkansas. There are only 28 employees living in Louisiana.

After discussion of the expansion of Superior Uniform Group all council members voted yes to the new contract.


The second item on the agenda is a Proposed Amendment: General Fund – Authorizing the mayor to purchase (2) used sheriff Vehicles in the amount of \$5,400.00 each. Chief Smith asked the council to purchase two used police cars from the Sheriff's Department in the amount of \$5,440.00 each. The cars are road ready. Mileage on the cars is between 84,000-93,000. To re-decal the cars would cost \$700.00 each and \$300.00 for labor.

Alderman Serio made the motion to purchase the 2 vehicles from the sheriff's department in the amount of \$10,800.00 and to amend the budget. Alderman Taylor seconded the motion. There were 7 yeas and 1 nay. Alderman Allen voted no.

Alderman Farris made the motion to adjourn the meeting and Alderman Taylor seconded the motion. Motion carried. The meeting is adjourned.
