MINUTES OF THE EUDORA CITY COUNCIL  
SPECIAL CALL MEETING  
MAY 29. 2014

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mayor Stanton. There were six aldermen present at roll call. Aldermen Serio and Taylor were absent.

The water/sewer supervisor salary was discussed. Mayor Stanton informed the council with the resignation of Mr. Morphis the city was out of compliance the month of April. As long as the water/sewer supervisor position is vacant, each customer must receive a letter stating that the city doesn't have a water/sewer supervisor and it must be published in the local paper. Mr. Arthur James was hired on May 1, 2014. He was highly recommended by Mr. Jack Gregg. He was hired at a rate of \$500.00 per week with no taxes. A total salary of \$26,000.00 per year. He will work two hours a day and on call in case of an emergency. The position was advertised in the Chicot Spectator and the Arkansas Democrat Gazette with no responses. After several suggestions, Alderman Tisdale made the motion to continue service on temp bases and current rate, contingent on both parties agreeing to a written contract. Alderman Farris second the motion. Motion carried.

Mayor Stanton spoke with the council on the grant to resurface the road around the parking lot at Superior Uniform Group. No action was taken due to mayor accidentally leaving the paperwork on desk.



The council and mayor discussed the 2014 budget to determine the status of the budget. Each individual budget was discussed. It was determined that the budget would remain as is for now.


