MINUTES FOR SPECIAL CALL MEETING JULY 10, 2012

There were six aldermen present at roll call. Mr. Butler and Mrs. Serio arrived shortly after.

The purpose of this meeting is to discuss the budget and make the necessary adjustment to the expenditures.

Mayor Stanton informed the counsel and citizens that Judge Ball will meet this week with the Quorum Court and Sheriff Nichols and get back with him on the outcome of the meeting.

The mayor also informed the counsel that he made contact with a federal program to hire a person through this agency to be the city inspector. The agency will pay this person's salary (\$7.25 per hour). This person will work four (4) hours per day. After six months the city will pick up this person's salary.

Judge Mazzanti reported to the council that a person had been in jail for thirty (30) days in Lake Village and a person in the Hamburg jail for ninety (90) days. He will speak with Judge Bridewell to try and relax the order. Ninety days in jail equals to about \$2,700.00. He also spoke with Judge Bridewell about a workplace program and she wasn't in favor of. He will speak with Reynolds Meyers about a house arrest program instituted in Eudora.

Alderman Jones made the motion that the mayor speak with Reynolds Meyers about instituting a house arrest program, ankle bracelets and the supervision of a work release program in Eudora. Alderman Turner seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Mr. Terrell told the council that the IRS bill has not been settled. He sent more documents in two weeks ago. Overtime pay is still happening. Department heads should take charge of timesheets. A letter concerning overtime pay dated June 26, 2012 was refused by employees.

Ordinance 2012-01 excluded any overtime pay for all departments. Each department has to check monthly expenditures against budget or monies will be frozen.

Alderman Thomas made the motion to adjourn the meeting and Alderman Scott seconded the motion. The meeting is adjourned.
